The week of prayer for Christian Unity concludes on Wednesday, the feast of the conversion of St. Paul, but we must always strive to work together with our fellow Christians in striving to spread the Good News of the Gospel and find ways to help others in their quest to discover the presence of Christ in their everyday lives.

### *A Reflection on Today's Gospel*

The hymn "Pescador de Hombres" by Cesareo Gabarain means "Fishers of Men." It describes the calling of the disciples. The refrain, in Spanish, shows Jesus looking into the eyes of the fishermen, gently smiling and speaking their names. At that, they simply abandon their boats there on the sand. They want to be close to Jesus as together they will find other seas.

The startling thing about this Gospel and their call to discipleship is that they immediately leave what they are doing. Simon, Andrew, James and John, the first of the disciples of Jesus, are fishing on the western shore of the sea of Galilee, near Capharnaum. Jesus calls them and they go. They won't be home any time soon.

If we choose to be disciples of Jesus, we too are expected to drop what we are doing today and immediately follow Jesus forever. These days most of us are so busy, our lives so hectic, that we don't have time to

**PARISH FINANCE:** Last weekend you gave £714.00 – thank you

**JULIA'S FUND** – the second collection last weekend realised £188.00 – sincere thanks to all those who contributed. During Advent we realised a further £102.91 - the total raised being £290.00.

Julia's Fund exists to help parishioners in need. Applications are received in confidence by Fr. Jim who will then seek the approval of those who administer the fund (Judy Flynn (Chair of the PPC), Joe Burns (Head of St. Norbert's School) & Deacon Dennis. Fr. Stanislaw Kowalski has been invited to join the trustees).

**Parish Mission:** We had an excellent attendance at the open meeting that took place after the 11.00am Mass last weekend. The meeting was facilitated by Mary Hurst and sixteen people were present, three apologies were received.

Mary informed the group that the idea of a parish mission was first discussed at the most recent meeting of the Parish Pastoral Council, and explained that she had been invited to lead the meeting that was taking place. Those who attended the PPC meeting felt it was a good idea to pursue the possibility of a mission in 2018. Fr. Jim was asked to raise the matter with the Parish Finance Committee; they too, were in agreement, provided that there be a fundraising drive towards the costs, and were in agreement that the parish would try to make up any shortfall.

Fr. Jim shared some of his experiences organising missions in previous parishes – and shared with the group his experience of organising a mission in his previous parish in 2006.

Norma Beveridge and a number of other parishioners shared their memories of the last mission to have taken place in Spalding in 1991 – it brought back many fond memories of the priests and team who led the mission – the church was full every night of the mission, and there were memories of wonderful liturgies....

**There was full agreement** that we should plan for a parish mission, if possible for June 2018 to incorporate the feast of St. Norbert on the 6th June.

Those present were invited to do some research and think about who could be invited to lead the mission, a religious order such as the Redemptorists, the Franciscans were two examples.

We will meet again after the 11.00am Mass on the 19th February when some thought will be given into what we consider the needs of this parish at the present time – **these meetings are open to the entire parish.**
